Please consider volunteering to be a team captain when you sign-up. The leagues cannot run without volunteer team captains.

- 7) Mens Triples (partners drawn)
- 8) Terry London Non Winners Open Singles\* (first round losers to non winners plate)
- 9) The Dave Banfield 2 Wood Open Singles (open to men and ladies)
- 10) Mixed Pairs (enter as a pair)
- 11) Bernard King Trophy (open to men and ladies, 2 sets of 9 ends)
- 12) Senior Citizens Mixed Pairs (enter as a pair, both players age 60+)
- \* Open to Members who have not previously won the Men's Singles, Ladies Singles, Bernard King or Non Winners Singles
- \*\* All Ladies Pairs and Triples games to be played on fixed date see entry form

#### **Kent County Representation Matches**

#### **Kent League**

After various discussions between clubs, the format of the Ladies Kent League will be amended to 5 rinks over 18 ends.

There is no change to the Mens Kent League.

Notices and team selection arrangements will be as per last season.

If you haven't played in a Kent League match before, but would like to learn more, please speak with any Bowling Committee member. The Bowling Committee is committed to integrate as many of our new bowlers as possible into our Kent League squads (we had a good number of new bowlers integrate into our mens Kent League squad last season).

ps if you would like to gain experience of playing rinks in preparation for these Kent League games, then men should consider joining the Thursday evening club rinks league.

#### **Selection for County and National Club Matches**

The Club plays in a number of mens and ladies National / County club competitions.

The relevant competitions are ...

#### Men

(National) Denny Cup. 16 bowlers playing 2 home rinks and 2 away rinks (National) Denny Plate. For first round Denny Cup losers (National) Over-60s Double Rink. 8 bowlers playing 1 home rink and 1 away rink (Kent) Dudley Hoile. 8 bowlers playing 1 home rink and 1 away rink (3 teams entered)

#### Ladies

(National) Yetton Trophy. 16 bowlers playing 2 home rinks and 2 away rinks (National) Yetton Plate. For first round Yetton Trophy losers (National) Vivienne. 12 bowlers playing 2 home rink and 2 away triples (Kent) Vallandor

#### Mixed

(National) Top Club. 11 players playing 1 mixed rink, triple & pair, & mens & ladies singles (National) Egham Trophy. 16 players playing 2 home mixed rinks and 2 away mixed rinks

As a Club, our selection strategy is to achieve a balance between selecting teams that will do as well as possible this season, whilst at the same time building a squad to be even stronger in future seasons. All members will be considered for selection for these matches, with performance in other (internal and external) competitions and matches such as the Kent League taken into account.

The mens teams will be selected by: Trevor London, Peter Harris and Chris Marchant. The ladies teams will be selected by Ladies Captains

### **Bowling Notices in the Club**
