From the Board.

Renewals

Membership renewals are due in this month. Please note that if you pay by bank transfer you must put your membership number and surname as the reference so that your payment can be credited to the right person. Where applicable, your invoice will include a new £5 annual locker rental.

Membership fees remain unchanged for another year, but rink fees will increase by 5% so that we can keep abreast of increases in our running costs. Rink fees will be for 2.5 hours only, or 1 hour booked on the day.

Note the only exception would be during the winter season which, to accommodate ladies' Kent league on a Wednesday that needs to run from 14:00 until 17:30; the rinks both before and after these times will be for 2 hour slots only, as shown on the Bowlr diary and charged as such.

Bowling Shoes

To all members, the new carpet is being fitted during the week commencing September 14th This is the club's biggest asset, costing around £47K, without a carpet the club wouldn't exist, therefore, a good maintenance programme is needed. You may be aware that we have a 10 strong carpet cleaning team whose work is essential for the life of the carpet. To ensure that we get the best and longest life from this investment we will be enforcing the EIBA (England Indoor Bowls Association) rules on bowls shoes. The rules are:

• The soles and the heels part of the shoe which come into contact with the carpet are completely smooth.

Only proprietary brands will be allowed as High Street brands such as Paver, Sketchers and others are not bowls shoes.

Bowls shoes can only be worn inside the club and must not be worn outdoors.

Please do not be offended if you are asked by a club member to show the soles of your shoes. If deemed unacceptable you will be asked to remove them or leave the green. We need to ensure that we all take the best care of the carpet so that it lasts as for long as possible. With care this carpet should comfortably last until the end of our lease in 2037.

In June, Bowls England and the English Indoor Bowling Association (EIBA) were pleased to announce they have been granted funding from Sport England to explore the potential of amalgamating as one organisation. Sport England's investment will enable dedicated project management resources and expertise to be allocated to this venture, as well as legal support to help create a new governance structure and corporation. We have now engaged the support of specialist consultants, Campbell Tickell.

Bowls England and EIBA believe that merging will help unlock our potential, increasing our capability to grow participation and tackle inequalities in sport. It would provide one voice for flat green bowls, an improved and streamlined experience for existing bowlers, a more straightforward and effective service for clubs, and consistency on policies and compliance matters. Furthermore, we would be able to release efficiency savings by avoiding duplication, which can be reinvested back into our sport.

As part of understanding the views of the bowls community, Bowls England and EIBA will be conducting a research programme including surveys and consultation sessions, starting with County Associations at the Aviva National Bowls Finals. This engagement and feedback will shape the development of a final proposal for a new National Governing Body.

To check the pulse of the bowls community on this journey, we would be grateful if those interested would complete a short survey, as well as passing onto club members, friends and family. This is the first stage of the consultation.
