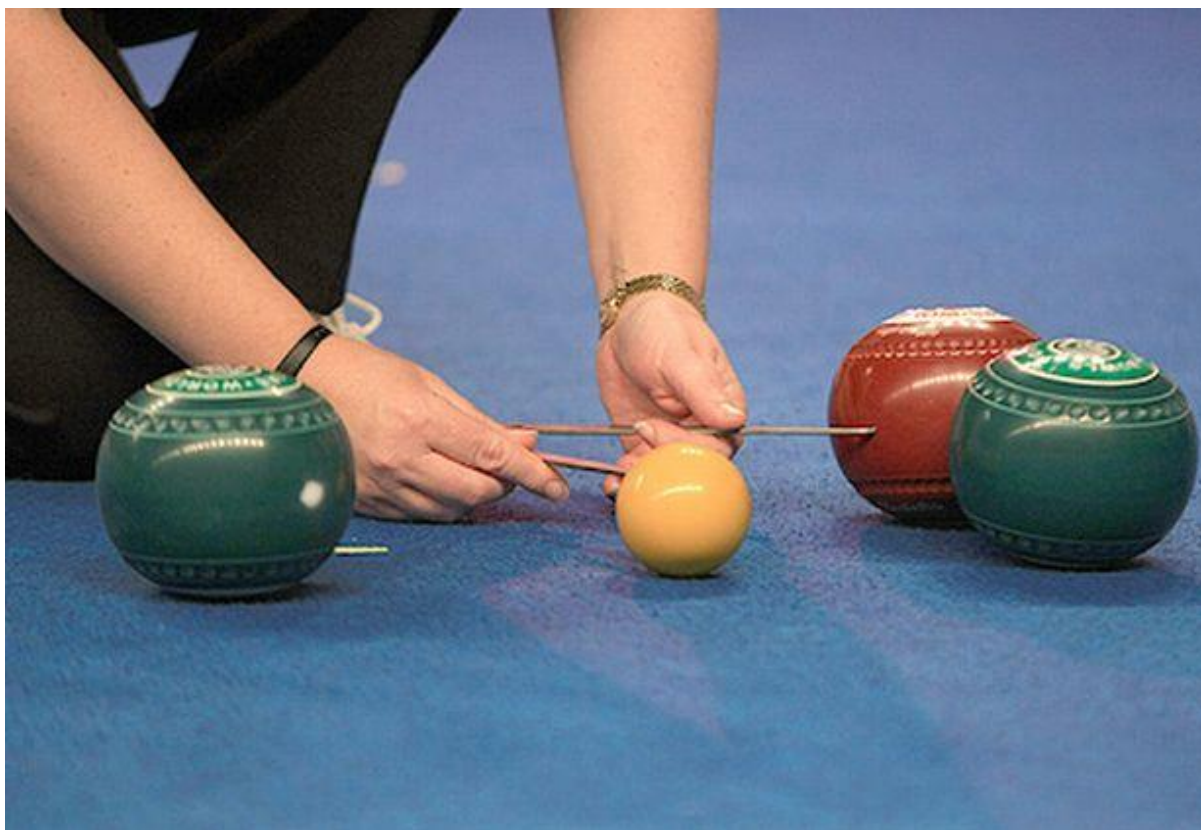

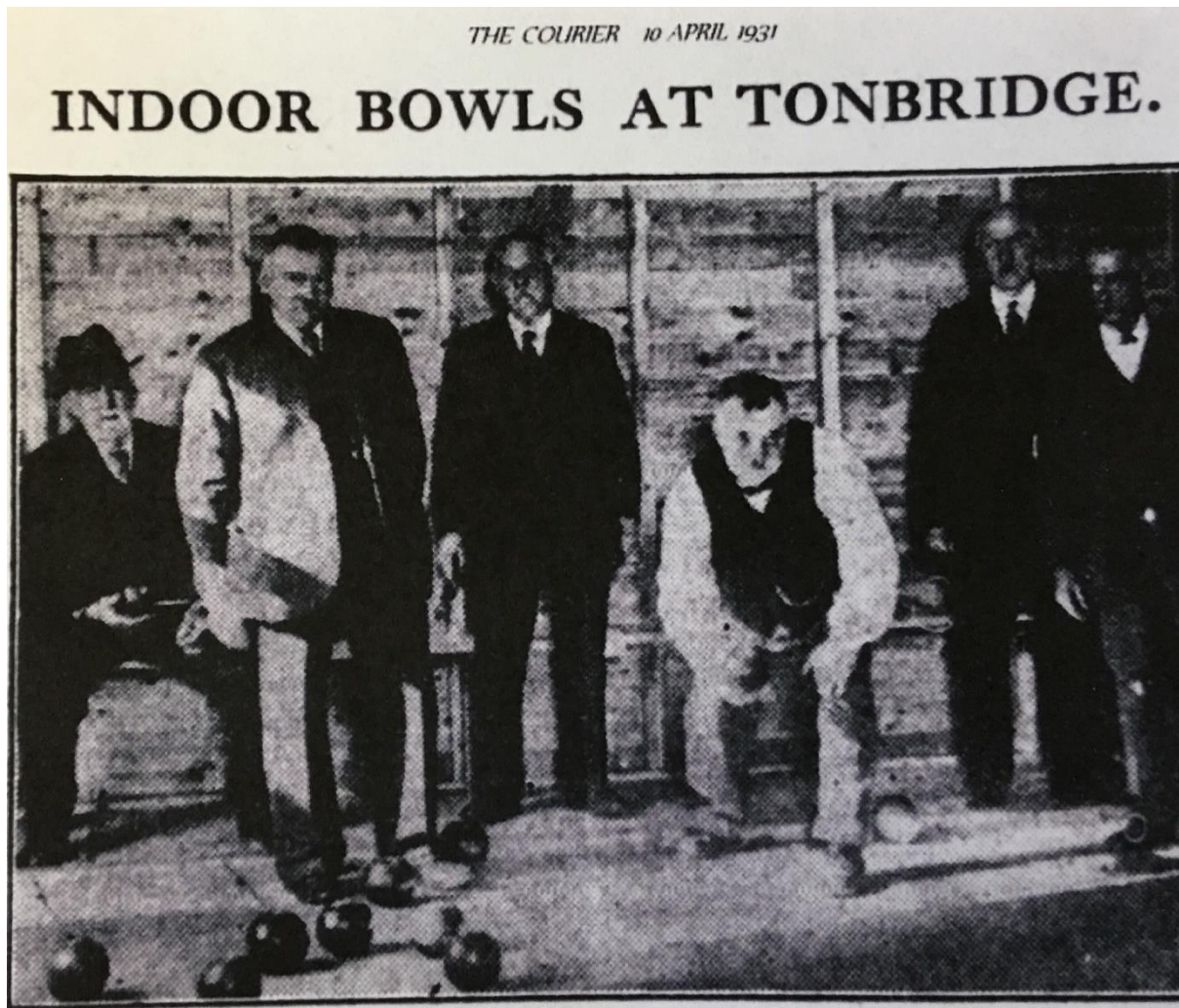
IN MEMORIAM

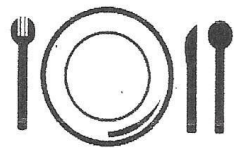
